Front Seat Belt




Removal/Installation

CAUTION: Check the front seat belts for damage, and replace them if necessary. Be careful not to damage them during removal and installation.

Front seat belt:

- 1. Slide the front seat forward fully.
- Remove (see section 20).
 - Door sill molding
 - Door trim
 - Quarter window trim
 - Rear seat cushion and rear seat-back
 - Side trim panel
- 3. Remove the upper anchor cap, lower anchor cap and seat belt guide.




 Remove all the anchor bolts and the retractor bolt, remove the retractor mounting bolt, then remove the front seat belt and retractor. 5. Installation is the reverse of the removal procedure.


NOTE:


- Check that the retractor locking mechanism functions as described on page 24-7.
- Make sure you assemble the washers and collars on the upper and lower anchor bolts as shown.
- Before installing the anchor bolts, make sure there are no twists or kinks in the front seat belt.

Lower anchor bolt construction:





Removal/Installation (cont'd)


Seat belt buckle:

- 1. Remove the front seat (see section 20).
- Driver's: Remove the cap. Remove the center cover mounting screw, detach the connector, then pull out the seat belt switch harness from the seat linkage. Passenger's: Remove the center cover (see section 20).



3. Remove the center anchor bolt, then remove the seat belt buckle.

4. Installation is the reverse of the removal procedure.

NOTE: Make sure you assemble the washers and bushing on the center anchor bolt as shown.
