# Static When Adjusting the Radio Volume

### PROBLEM

Static comes from the speakers when the radio volume is first adjusted. The noise coincides with the movement of the volume knob, and will usually stop after a few consecutive movements of the knob. The problem may recur when the volume knob is readjusted after the vehicle has been sitting for several hours.

## **CORRECTIVE ACTION**

Replace the radio with a remanufactured unit listed under PARTS INFORMATION.

NOTE: All remanufactured units have been improved to eliminate this problem.
