


- 1. Air Cleaner Remove


2. Remove the line pressure switch (A) with the sealing washer (B).


1. Line Pressure Switch - Install

- 1. Install the line pressure switch (A) using a new sealing washer (B). Tighten the switch by gripping the metal part, not the plastic part.
 - 2. Connect the line pressure switch connector (A) securely.**NOTE:** Check the connector for corrosion, dirt, or oil, and clean or repair if necessary.



- 2. Battery Base Install
 - 1. Install the battery base .
- 3. Battery Install
 - 1. Do the battery installation procedure .
- 4. Air Cleaner Install
 - 1. Install the air cleaner.
