




(2013-18) > REMOVAL

- 1. Fuel Pressure Relieve
 - 1. Relieve the fuel pressure.
- 2. Rear Seat Cushion Remove
 - 1. Remove the rear seat cushion Refer to: Rear Seat Removal and Installation (2013-18), or Rear Seat Removal and Installation(With Seat Heater) (2016-18).
- 3. Fuel Tank Unit Access Panel Remove
- 1. Remove the access panel (A) from the floor



2. Disconnect the fuel tank unit connector (B).

4. Fuel Line Quick-Connect Fitting - Disconnect




- 1. Place a rag or shop towel (A) over the quick-connect fitting.
- 2. Disconnect the quick-connect fitting from the fuel tank unit .

5. Fuel Tank Unit Locknut - Loosen

1. Using the fuel nut wrench, loosen the fuel tank unit locknut (A).



6. Fuel Tank Unit - Remove






1. Fuel Tank Unit - Temporarily Insert

- 1. Temporarily insert the fuel tank unit (A) into the fuel tank with a new O-ring (B).
 - 1. Be careful not to damage the new O-ring.
 - 2. Be careful not to bend the fuel gauge sending unit.
 - 3. Do not coat the base gasket with oil.

2. Fuel Tank Unit - Align

1. Align the marks (A) on the fuel tank and fuel tank unit, then insert the fuel tank unit into the fuel tank.

NOTE: To avoid a fuel leak, check the base gasket, visually or by hand, to make sure it is not pinched.

3. Fuel Tank Unit - Install



1. Tighten a new locknut (A) by hand holding the fuel tank unit vertically.

NOTE: Before tightening, align the mark (B) on the locknut to the start of the thread (C).

Fig 1: Fuel Pump Locknut With Torque Specifications




2. Using the fuel nut wrench, tighten the locknut to the specified torque.

NOTE:

- 1. After tightening, make sure the marks (A) are still aligned.
- 2. After installation, check the base gasket, visually or by hand, to make sure it is not pinched.
- 4. Fuel Line Quick-Connect Fitting Connect
- 1. Connect the quick-connect fitting (A) to the fuel tank unit .




5. Fuel Leak - Check

- 1. Connect the fuel tank unit connector (A)
- 2. Press the engine start/stop button to select the ON mode (but do not operate the starter motor). The fuel pump runs for about 2 seconds, and fuel pressure rises. Repeat this two or three times, then make sure there are no fuel leaks.

6. Fuel Tank Unit Access Panel - Install



1. Install the access panel (A) to the floor.
